Background Information

We are seeking a Literacy Catalyst to work with students, Education Assistants and Teachers at the school.

As the school's on-site Literacy Catalyst, you will be working with all teachers, EAs, and students from K4 to grade 12. As an integral part of the Literacy Team, you will implement and model best practice to ensure students are receiving the best literacy instruction.

As a Literacy Catalyst, your duties will include, but are not limited to, the following tasks:

- Administering reading screeners and diagnostics
- Helping track and collect assessment results and other data
- Working in classes on literacy lessons, and with Teachers and Education Assistants on literacy goals set by the Literacy Consultant
- Working one-on-one and with small groups of students on literacy goals
- Reviewing progress with the Inclusive Education Team
- Taking direction from and working closely with the Literacy Consultant
- Attending professional development

This is a temporary, grant-funded position for the 2024/2025 school year. Pay is competitive and will be based on training and experience.
